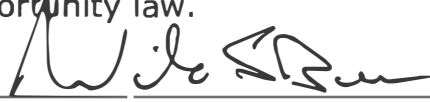
NOTICE TO EMPLOYEES

This Notice is posted pursuant to an order by the United States Equal Employment Opportunity Commission dated September 10, 2025 which found that a violation of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VII), as amended, 42 U.S.C. § 2000e et seq., has occurred at the Agency's Perquimans/Chowan County Service Center in Hertford, North Carolina (hereinafter this facility).

Federal law requires that there be no discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment because of the person's RACE, COLOR, RELIGION, SEX, NATIONAL ORIGIN, AGE, or DISABILITY with respect to hiring, firing, promotion, compensation, or other terms, conditions or privileges of employment.

This facility was found to have violated Title VII when management officials subjected an employee to discrimination in their hiring process. This facility was ordered to: pay proven compensatory damages, pay backpay, and provide EEO training to the responsible management officials, among other remedies.

This facility will comply with federal law and will not in any manner restrain, interfere, coerce, or retaliate against any individual who exercises his or her right to oppose practices made unlawful by, or who participates in proceedings pursuant to, federal equal employment opportunity law.
